## HOMECOMING POSTER:

In the grand tradition of Homecomings past, the parents of the XC runners will be creating a poster for their own son(s). Volunteers will slip the poster over a wire frame and then set them up in the middle part of the course for the entire world to see. The boys really have a good time looking at all of their teammates' posters.

1. Buy a standard sheet of poster board (28 x 22) from Meijers, Wal Mart, CVS, etc.
2. Fold the poster board in half so that it is ½ the height, not ½ the width.
3. Decorate the outside of each half. The two halves of the sign will be placed over a wire frame on the XC course for the September 24 meet

### SIDE ONE:

Create a 'tribute' to your son. It can be as serious or funny as you wish; this is good place for some of the blackmail pictures you have taken in the past. A suggestion for seniors is a serious one celebrating all their years of XC. For underclassmen we can much more amusing. Pictures, clipart, mementos, you name it, almost anything tasteful goes.

### SIDE TWO:

This is more a team side. Pictures of lions, runners, your son's running pictures, sayings like 'Go Lions', 'Homecoming 2019', his graduation year, etc. Be sure your son's name is prominently displayed on both sides.

**Your sign doesn't have to be a work of art. It is intended to show your son your appreciation of the effort he puts into an extremely demanding sport; this is our time to show them that we acknowledge their time and commitment.**

1. You can deliver your sign to Coach Smith's Apartment and put it in the box on the front porch. Coach Smith lives directly at the corner of Pontiac Trail and Eleven Mile Rd. His apartment faces both 11 and Pontiac Trail: 11035 Eleven Mile., Apartment 1.  
The box will be available Sat., Sept 14. DO NOT put it there after 2:30 on Tuesday, Sept 24
2. You can deliver your sign directly to Island Lake on Tuesday, September 24 and staple it directly to a wire yourself. Please have your sign in place between 2:30 and 3:15.
